Today's itinerary explores the iconic Barossa Valley, visiting Angaston, Mengler Hill, Tanunda and Seppeltsfield.

With a modest total distance of only 60km, you'll have plenty of time to stop and smell the roses or taste a few wines (in moderation, we still have to pedal). A highlight for the day, near the end of the ride, will be a visit to Maggie Beers Farm Shop with a pre-prepared lunch pack included.
